Users must ensure they are using the proper mounts that match their barrel threads and there is a proper shoulder for the mount to set against. Following these instructions will help to prevent the problems and dangers that can arise from improper installation.

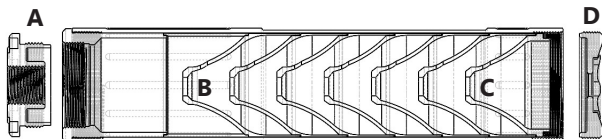

Disassemble/Assemble

To Disassemble: Remove front end cap with tool provided, remove baffle stack. If baffles do not come out easily, insert a dowel that fits into the back of silencer and push baffles out of tube. Tip: Soaking overnight with some lubrication like CLP helps greatly if the baffles are difficult to move. Once out, soak baffles(only) in multi-use CLR for one hour for easy cleaning.

To Assemble: Stack baffles on flat surface starting with end baffle, with cone facing up. Stack them like shown on diagram below. Baffles are notched, the last baffle on the stack will not have notches in the front. Another good practice is to align notches of baffles with engraving on silencer tube. Slide tube over baffle stack and screw endcap on and tighten to about 40in-lbs.

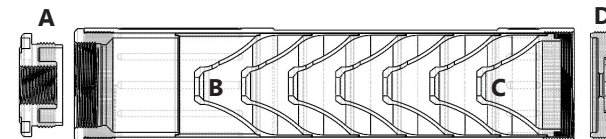

Disassemble/Assemble

To Disassemble: Remove front end cap with tool provided, remove baffle stack. If baffles do not come out easily, insert a dowel that fits into the back of silencer and push baffles out of tube. Tip: Soaking overnight with some lubrication like CLP helps greatly if the baffles are difficult to move. Once out, soak baffles(only) in multi-use CLR for one hour for easy cleaning.

To Assemble: Stack baffles on flat surface starting with end baffle, with cone facing up. Stack them like shown on diagram below. - **Maintenance**
